

The key aim of Needle Exchange provision is to

Reduce the transmission of HIV, Hepatitis and other infectious diseases, and contribute to the health of service users and the wider community.

Needle Exchanges do this in a number of ways including:

-  Providing sterile injecting equipment
-  Ensuring the safe disposal of used equipment
-  Giving advice and information about ways to make injecting less dangerous
-  Promoting alternatives to intravenous drug use
-  Signposting clients to other services

Needle Exchange Services:

Needle and syringe exchange is available through selected pharmacies and drug treatment agencies displaying the needle exchange logo.

Naloxone is available through our specialist needle Exchange at Rosslyn House DN1 2EZ - **03000 213900** This is a lifesaving drug in the event of opiate overdose.

What to do in an emergency (recovery position)

If someone is unconscious and breathing, put them in the recovery position

- ▶ Open their airway by tilting the head back and lifting the chin
- ▶ Straighten the legs
- ▶ Place the arm nearest to you at right angle to their body
- ▶ Pull the arm furthest from you across their chest and place the back of their hand against the cheek nearest to you
- ▶ Get hold of the far leg, just above the knee, and pull on the upper leg to roll them towards you, and onto their side
- ▶ Tilt the head back to make sure they can breathe easily
- ▶ Make sure that both the hip and the knee of the upper leg are bent at right angles
- ▶ Dial 999 and ask for an ambulance
- ▶ Stay with them until the ambulance arrives
